. Find out why this landmark landmark is not on the World Heritage List and the threat it faces. This landmark is threatened by the privatization of the key elements of its management. Sites and Cultural Properties were placed on the List of World Heritage in Danger when insufficient actions have been taken to protect them and enhance their cultural or natural significance. The most critical threat is generally a loss of ownership of the property and its adjacent lands (a.k.a. Jurisdictional Change) or the significant alteration of the type of management needed to sustain the property. These threats can also be combined or individual to any of the elements of the World Heritage property. The Committee requested information from the State Party on the measures that it has taken to prevent and mitigate the effects of the risk of deterioration to the property. The State Party reported that it had established the advisory Committee for the State Property of Asean on Mananara, and the Bureau of Environment and Natural Resources had created an office for the management of the property in partnership with UNESCO. It also reported that it had given priority to the creation of a study unit and that an exhibition on the property was scheduled to open in the future. In addition, the Committee requested information on the relevant legal acts and their implementation, including any measures taken to prevent and mitigate the effects of Jurisdictional Change and the privatization of management functions. The State Party provided a general description of the legal framework for the property and its management. The Committee was concerned that the general description provided by the State Party did not include detailed information on the relevant laws and regulations, the implementation of any management function, or the ownership of the property. It therefore requested a detailed legal analysis of the relevant provisions of legislation, and details on the implementation of relevant management functions, including relevant measures that would be taken to prevent and mitigate the risk of deterioration. The State Party provided the information and explanation requested in the form of a letter from the Prime Minister to the Committee. In its report (noted below), the Committee expressed its general satisfaction with the State Party's efforts to address the risks of deterioration and lack of management but requested further measures to address the main issue of privatization of management functions. It also requested further information on the relevant laws and regulations, the implementation of relevant management functions, and the ownership of the property. The State Party submitted its report on 25 February 2012, which provided additional information. It stated that, in response to the Committee's request, 82157476af
